

## 01 Prepare & Submit →



Be prepared to submit these documents:

- Official Transcript in Original Language
- Certified English Translation of Transcripts
- Certified English Proficiency Testing and/or Admission/Academic Testing Results
- Copy of Passport

## 02 Interview →

## 03 Confirm Your Place →

- Accepted students will receive an enrollment packet with documents to be completed by the student
- To reserve the student's place, the tuition deposit of \$5,000 USD must be received by the deadline indicated

- Upon processing of the enrollment documents and the tuition deposit, students will be issued their Form I-20 —see instructions below for obtaining the student visa.

## 04 Get Your Visa →

- To study in the United States, the student will need to apply for an F-1 visa with the local U.S. Embassy or Consulate
- Students will then schedule and complete a visa interview

- Once the visa is approved, the balance of tuition and fees will be due at a specified date prior to arrival
- If the visa is not approved, the deposit will be refunded (less \$1,000 for administrative fees) upon receipt of the original I-20 form and a proof of denial.

## Entry Requirements →

To be eligible for the Amerigo programs at the Amerigo Boca Raton, Amerigo Chicago, Amerigo Chicago North Shore, Amerigo Lexington, Amerigo Maryland, Amerigo New Jersey, and Amerigo Twin Cities campuses\*, an applicant must meet the following requirements:
